



Faculty Position in Social Work

Position:

Roberts Wesleyan College Department of Social Work MSW Program invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track Assistant/Associate position, immediate opening starting in the fall semester 2015.

Department of Social Work:

The vision of the Social Work Department is to lead the advancement of integrating Christian faith with social work practice, scholarship, and service locally, nationally, and internationally. Our department has 10 faculty members across our BSW and MSW program. Enrollment growth in the MSW program has been trending upward necessitating a new hire. The MSW program currently has concentrations in Mental Health and in Child and Family Services.

Qualifications:

Applicants must have an MSW and preferably a completed or almost completed Ph.D. in social work or a related field. Candidates must demonstrate strong teaching skills, have a record of scholarship and demonstrate a Christian faith commitment consistent with the mission of the institution. Candidates with at least two years post-M.S.W. social work practice experience in areas such as community organizing, administration, organizational development, non-profit leadership, grant writing and work with nongovernment organizations (NGOs) are preferred.

Responsibilities:

Teach primarily in the MSW Program; provide academic advisement; serve as field liaison; serve on Department and College committees and maintain a record of scholarship and professional activity.

Application Process:
