- Earned doctorate in social work or a related field

- Masters Degree in Social Work
- At least 2 years post MSW experience in practice with vulnerable populations
- Knowledge of and experience in social work research
- Knowledge of the funding process and/or success with funded research
- Teaching experience including online courses
- Experience with diverse populations
- Substantive expertise in behavioral health, healthcare, diversity and/or practice
