

Jacksonville State University (JSU) seeks applicants for a nine (9) month tenure-track faculty position for the BSW program in the Department of Sociology and Social Work to start in the fall of 2013. The BSW program is accredited by the Council on Social Work Education and prepares undergraduate students for entry-level generalist social work practice.

Jacksonville State University is located in Jacksonville, Alabama, the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains. As the "Friendliest Campus in the South," we are announcing an open faculty position in the Department of Sociology and Social Work.

This position is responsible for instructional work to facilitate student comprehension and application of the knowledge, values and skills for the social work profession that contribute to the development of mature, competent and responsible professionals in society. This position exists to provide educational services to traditional and non-traditional students during the day and evening. This position requires teaching courses within the social work program on campus in a traditional classroom setting, hybrid courses and online courses depending on need.

This position requires development and implementation of a program of instruction that meets the individual needs, interests and abilities of students and is consistent with the university, SACS and CSWE accreditation, as well as, state study and curriculum guides. In order to maximize student achievement, faculty should be able to assess student abilities as related to desired educational goals and objectives. Faculty plan and employ a variety of appropriate instructional/learning strategies and activities which are compatible with the physical facility and serves the needs and capabilities of the students. In order to provide a general environment conducive to the learning process, the professor should be able to manage the behaviors of learners in the classroom and participate in the management of student behavior in other parts of the campus. Faculty communicate to students (either in writing or verbally) instructional expectations, student progress or lack of progress. The instructor actively participates in and works with university personnel in planning effective instructional goals, objectives, methods and curriculum. The individual must exhibit a commitment and ability to conduct scholarly activities, including but not limited to, research, publications, and presentations and also engage in professional, university, and community service. Participation in professional growth and development is required.

Ph.D. or D.S.W. in Social Work or Social Welfare plus MSW and two years full-time post-MSW direct Social Work practice experience required.

Faculty responsibilities include student advising, committee assignments, and professional activities of research, presentation and publication, as well as program, school, university and community service. Position requires the ability to teach across the Social Work professional curriculum.

Position closing date is March 31, 2013 and requested starting date is August 16, 2013.
