**This position is ideal for a passionate, mission driven manager that is committed to addressing the critical and emerging needs facing seniors and adults with disabilities in our community. This leadership role requires someone with the ability to convene, facilitate and take part in the community-wide discussion about the health and well being of seniors and adults with disabilities in our community to produce measurable outcomes. This position combines thought leadership, grantmaking, community convening, issues leadership advocacy and strong communication skills.**

**POSITION OVERVIEW**

The United Way of Allegheny County (United Way) is seeking a Manager, Community Outcomes for Vulnerable Seniors & Adults with Disabilities (Manager) to join its talented team of community change leaders. Pennsylvania has the second oldest population in the nation. In Allegheny County, the senior population is even higher with almost one of every five citizens being a senior and a sharply increasing number of seniors age 85 and older. The research is compelling that seniors can be healthy and live happily into their 80's, 90's, or even 100's if they have appropriate supports and make the right choices to maintain their health during the senior years. Yet, far too many seniors in Allegheny County struggle with everyday life; are at risk of falls, other injuries, or preventable illnesses; and suffer from social isolation as they have out-lived spouses, family, and friends. Still many seniors who are on fixed incomes are required to choose between paying for basic living expenses, such as utilities and housing, or acquiring needed in-home support services.

The United Way is taking a leadership role in educating the community – and 60,000 donors – about the magnitude and seriousness of this issue. This newly created position will convene community partners and leaders to join with the United Way in developing action plans.

This position is central to ensuring that we achieve the desired impact around helping seniors and adults with disabilities be healthy and safe at home and that the more than \$42 Million this department invests is allocated wisely. Working in collaboration with other United Way staff, funding sources, service providers, and policy makers, the Manager provides leadership to define and address critical and emerging needs facing seniors and adults with disabilities. This position works within the United Way Community Impact department, and reports to the Director of Community Impact. This position does not have any direct reports, but does have significant community exposure, and works with numerous volunteer committees to advance the mission and accomplish the organization's objectives.
