Position 1: Community LEARNS Assistant Site Coordinator

Status: Part-time, 20-30 hours per week

Compensation: \$13 - \$16/Hour, commensurate with experience/training

Program Sites: Pittsburgh Brashear, Peabody, Schenley, and/or University Prep

This position will assist in the coordination of the educational services, employment services, mentoring, case management, and social and recreational programming of the Community LEARNS program. Positions are available working with students at Brashear, Peabody, Schenley at Reizenstein, and/or University Prep. The ideal candidate will be able to lead urban youth, strong supervision, communication and computer skills, an ability to take written and oral directions, enjoy working with urban teens, have a PA driver's license and insurance and be able to drive a 15 passenger van.

Position 2: Academic Tutor

Status: Part time, 10-15 hours per week, flexible

This position will tutor 9th – 12th grade youth who are voluntarily participating in afterschool program. Duties includes math and literacy tutoring and homework help.
