Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) is a developmental disorder affecting communication and behavior. ASD can be diagnosed at any age; however, symptoms typically emerge in a child's first two years (https://www.nimh.nih.gov/health/topics/autism-spectrum-disorders-asd/). Although children with ASD are not currently eligible for Intensive Family Coaching (IFC), they ARE eligible for Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT), of which IFC is an adaptation. At this month's LnL, our colleagues from Wesley Family Services will be providing an overview of ASD.
