Dementia Statistics

- 10.9% of American adults ages 65 and older are living with Alzheimer's type dementia (Alzheimer's Association, 2024).
- Over 11 million Americans are unpaid care partners for people with Alzheimer's or other dementias (Alzheimer's Association, 2024).
- These unpaid care partners provided an estimated 18.4 billion hours of care in 2023 (Alzheimer's Association, 2024).

- 11.5% of Pennsylvania adults over the age of 65 are living with Alzheimer's type dementia (Alzheimer's Association, 2024).
- Allegheny County has a higher population of older adults ages 60 and older (27%) than the national average (23%) (Area Agency on Aging, 2023).




Collaboration with AgeWell at the JCC

Cafes often featurefood, music, storytelling, movement & visuals that engage as many senses as possible stimulate memory & connection










