

Have you personally experienced or worked directly with individuals with experience of any form of inpatient psychiatric civil commitment in Pennsylvania, New York, Ohio, New Jersey, Maryland or California?



A research group at the University of Pittsburgh, led by Dr. Nev Jones, is conducting research to better understand experiences of initiation and entry into inpatient and outpatient civil commitment in Pennsylvania, Ohio, Maryland, California, New Jersey and New York. We are trying to learn more about how people end up on inpatient or outpatient orders, the impact of these experiences, and the perspectives of providers, attorneys, administrators and advocates working with individuals who have experienced involuntary treatment. We will be conducting one-time interviews by phone, Zoom, or, where possible, in person that will last approximately 60-75 minutes.

Who is eligible to participate?

Anyone who has experienced inpatient or outpatient civil commitment, in New York, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Maryland, California or New Jersey

OR

Family members, providers, attorneys, government administrators or advocates who have worked with individuals with experience of civil commitment

AND

who are 18 years of age or older and proficient in English.

All participants will be compensated \$60.
