The University of Chicago Crown School of Social Work, Policy and Practice (Crown Family School) invites applicants for a tenured position at the rank of Associate or Full Professor to start on or after July 1, 2022, whose scholarship focuses on educational inequality. We are particularly interested in scholars whose research focuses on urban areas and examines the intersection of education and other social systems. We are also seeking candidates who explore the experiences of people as they transition within and across systems. The ideal candidate would have a sustained program of research, conducted in partnership with schools.

Applicants must have a doctorate in education, social work, sociology or a related social science field. Applicants should submit a cover letter, a Curriculum Vita, a statement that outlines research and teaching interests, a sample of 2-3 current writings, and contact information for at least three references. Consideration of applications will begin on September 30, 2021, and will continue until the position is filled or the search is closed; early submission is encouraged.
